



## 2020 Health & Safety Policy

### IMPORTANT PLEASE READ CAREFULLY BEFORE ENTERING THE ODEUM EXPO CENTER

The health and safety of our guests is our top priority. We have implemented several measures that you will see in our facility which are each designed to protect Odeum Expo Center guests and employees from potential exposure to the COVID-19 virus ("Coronavirus"), by minimizing contacts, promoting social distancing and increasing sanitation throughout the venue.

In addition, to further protect the health and safety of our guests and employees, you will not be admitted to the Odeum and you should stay home if within past fourteen (14) days you have:

- Tested positive or have been deemed presumptively positive with the Coronavirus;
- Sought testing to determine whether you might have the Coronavirus, and have not yet received the results;
- Been informed that you may have been exposed to Coronavirus or learned that you have been in the immediate vicinity of a person now known to have been carrying the Coronavirus; or
- Experienced any of the following symptoms commonly associated with the Coronavirus, including cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, OR two or more of any of the following: fever, chills, repeated shaking with chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, new loss of taste or smell.

Prior to entering the Odeum Expo Center, you may undergo a non-invasive temperature check. If your temperature is 100.40 F or higher, you will be directed to one of our medical technicians to determine whether we can safely admit you to the facility. No personal information or data will be recorded or retained in any manner in connection with this process.

Once you enter the Odeum, you must:

- Wear your protective face mask at all times during your visit (other than children two and under); and
- Adhere to the social distancing and sanitization guidelines posted throughout the venue.

The Odeum Expo Center reserves the right to modify these requirements on a case-by-case basis to accommodate any circumstance that in the Odeum's sole discretion warrants a modification to this policy.

The Odeum Expo Center cannot guarantee that you will not be exposed to Coronavirus during your visit. The CDC advises that older adults and people of any age who have serious underlying medical conditions might be at higher risk for severe illness from Coronavirus. Guests should evaluate their own risk in determining whether to attend. People who show no symptoms can spread Coronavirus if they are infected, and any interaction with the general public poses an elevated risk of being exposed to Coronavirus. By coming to the Odeum Expo Center, you acknowledge and agree that you assume these inherent risks associated with attendance.

If at any time the Odeum determines that a guest does not meet the criteria outlined in this policy, the Odeum reserves the right to refuse entry or (if the guest is already in the facility) immediately remove the guest from the venue. These actions are at the sole discretion of the Odeum.

By entering the facility, you acknowledge that you have read, understand and agree to abide by this policy. If you have any questions, or if you do not understand the policy, please speak with guest relations.
